Business models

EC can participate in production, among others from renewable sources, supply, consumption, aggregation, energy storage, energy efficiency services or charging services for electric vehicles or the provision of other energy service to its members or shareholders.

Proportions are not set by the Law.

- Shareholders need to be financially involved
- business models created by themselves, putting themselves in the center as the main ones and responsible for all processes
- are obliged to bear risks and costs, but also to share profits.

- From the point of view of investment capital and ownership assets of business models EC can be categorized as:

- owned by members
- the property of a third party,
- a combination of these two forms is possible, i.e. a hybrid version

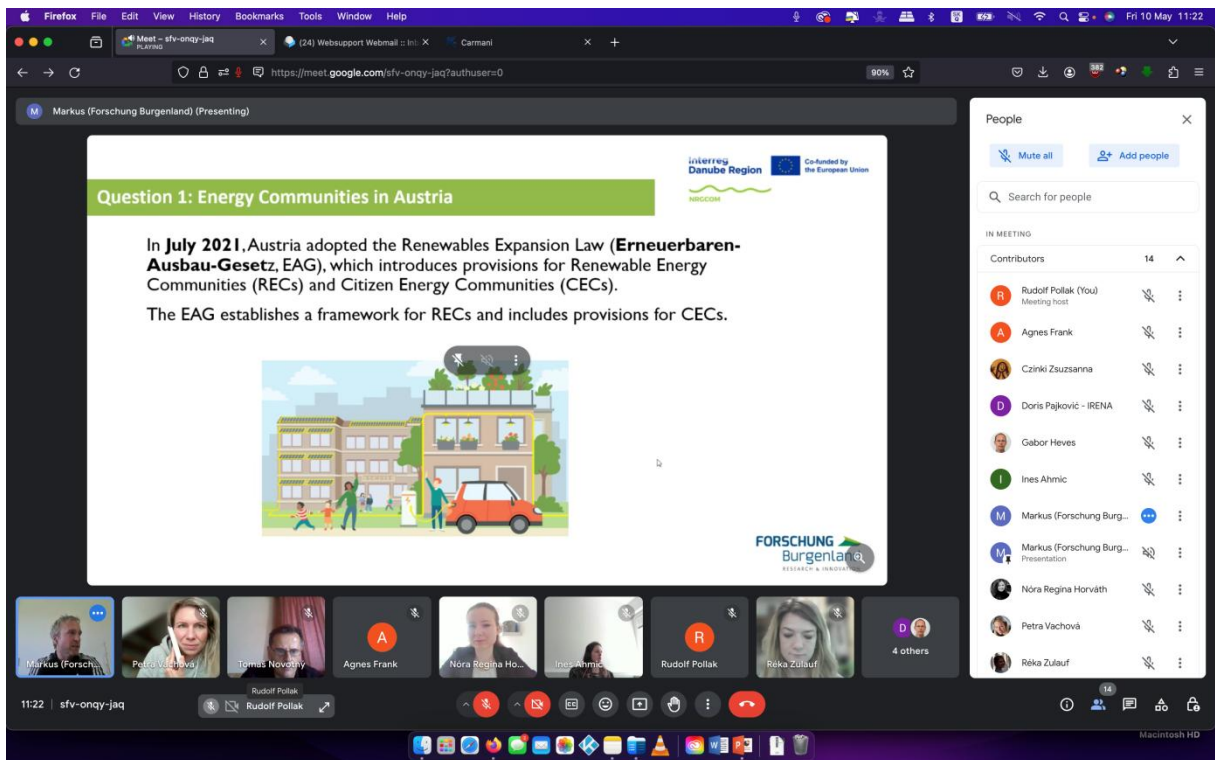
EC Forum in Croatia

- A favorable environment for the work and business of energy communities and ensuring their economic and financial sustainability, with a focus on solutions such as equal participation in the market, direct sharing of energy with members, and conclusion of contracts on the purchase and sale of energy directly with other actors on the market.
- The active role of cities and municipalities in the development of energy communities and civic energy projects on public areas and rooftops.
